BY LAW NO 6 – CRC SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY – RECIPROCAL RIGHTS VISITING MEMBER

This By Law relating to Categories of Membership is made by the Committee under clause 3.2 of the CRC Constitution.

Membership Category: Reciprocal Rights Visiting Member

Eligibility: The person must:

1. Be a financial full member of another ACT rowing club affiliated with Rowing ACT;
2. Be approved by the Club Captain, and satisfy the Captain she/he is a current financial member of another ACT rowing club;
3. Intend to row as a CRC visiting member on an occasional basis;
4. Use Club facilities and equipment only in the company of or under the direct supervision of an Ordinary member;
5. Sign the Guest book, noting the visitor's home club, prior to using any Club equipment;
6. Accept that limitations may be placed on the visitor's use of Club facilities and equipment, including but not limited to temporary or permanent exclusion from the Club, at the absolute discretion of the Committee.

Rights and privileges: Reciprocal Rights Visiting members will have no membership rights in relation to the Club nor in relation to use of CRC facilities or equipment. Reciprocal Rights Visiting members will be granted access to use Club facilities and equipment only while under the supervision of a host CRC member, and at the absolute discretion of the Committee.

Membership fee: No fee will be levied against approved Reciprocal Rights Visiting members. No Reciprocal Rights Visiting member may compete in any regatta as a member of CRC.
